Dear Father Kim,

I am following up with the Survey report dated September 23, 2019 documenting that all of the active parishioners over the age of 18 were invited to participate in a survey to determine their opinion on the possible move to the Renehan property and the level of financial support that they would be willing to offer for the relocation and building effort. The summary of the report is that 80% of the parishioners support the relocation and have reported a willingness to give approximately \$1.2 million towards this effort. In my May 21, 2019 letter to you, I established a schedule and timeline that did not contemplate surveying the parish referenced above. With the results affirming support to move to the Renehan property and at the request of the parish, on November 14, 2019 I approved and signed the architectural agreement between Quinn Evans Architects Inc. and the parish to initiate the master planning process.

With this letter, I am establishing a new schedule that by June 30, 2020 the parish is to have finalized its master plan, developed a business plan and schedule demonstrating how the parish can financially afford the move to the Renehan property. The Parish is also expected to file for a conditional use application with Howard County to implement the plan.

When the master plan and business plan are prepared, it is to be presented to the Archdiocesan Facilities and Real Estate Commission for comments and then presented to me for approval.

Over the last many years, much review and discussion have occurred about the best location for the parish to serve the Korean community. During the next six months, the parish is to finalize and present to me a clear vision for the future of the parish on the Renehan property. If the planning were to present technical or financial challenges that are insurmountable, then the parish is to remain at the current Security Blvd site and renovate and improve the current campus.
